What SPSC offers

Sun Prairie Soccer Club (SPSC) believes every child and adult prospers from the opportunity to play soccer. Playing for a SPSC team means having teammates and coaches dedicated to one another's development as soccer players and members of the soccer community.

SPSC head coaches are licensed by the United States Soccer Federation and the Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association. They are experienced in providing high-quality coaching and leadership to players at a variety of ages and are dedicated to helping players achieve their best. Our coaches are known for their excellent coaching and positive reinforcement. Further, SPSC believes that only through execution of a Possession Soccer Philosophy can individual players, and ultimately competitive teams, reach their full potential.

Players selected for competitive teams are expected to provide a high level of commitment and must attend practices, games and tournaments. They are expected to demonstrate a commitment to individual and team improvement. Travel is required for away games and tournaments and over-night stays may be required.

COMPETITIVE TEAMS: All players interested in competitive teams MUST try-out and every effort should be made to be at the try-out session for the ENTIRE time. Teams will be formed if there are enough players at a threshold skill level to field a team, and SPSC is able to provide appropriate coaching. If a player does not make a competitive team, they will be offered a roster spot on a recreational traveling team, if there is roster space.

Players selected for competitive teams are expected to provide a high level of commitment and must attend practices, games and tournaments. They are expected to demonstrate a commitment to individual and team improvement. Travel is required for away games and tournaments and over-night stays may be required.

 - U15 (born on or after August 1, 1995)— plays fall season only
 - U16 (born on or after August 1, 1994) — plays fall season only
 - U17 (born on or after August 1, 1993) — plays fall season only
 - U18-19 (born on or after August 1, 1991) — plays fall season only

TRYOUTS: In order to participate in girls tryouts, the following **MUST** be received by SPSC by **May 31, 2010**

- Completed Registration – preferably online
- Release of Liability form - this must be completed and SENT in for all players even those registering online
- Copy of player's birth certificate (If NOT previously turned in)
- Signed signature page from both the player and parent contract

- U12 (born on or after August 1, 1998)—plays both fall and spring seasons

- U15 (born on or after August 1, 1995)—plays spring season only
- U16 (born on or after August 1, 1994) — plays spring season only

TRYOUTS: In order to participate in spring coed tryouts for ages U11 – U14, the following **MUST** be received by SPSC by **May 31, 2010**

- Completed Registration – preferably online
- Release of Liability form - this must be completed and SENT in for all players even those registering online
- Copy of players birth certificate (If NOT previously turned in)
- Signed signature page from both the player and parent contract

In order to participate in fall coed tryouts for ages U15 and up, the materials listed above **MUST** be received by SPSC by **July 15, 2010**

Field Directions / Information:

Carriage Hill Estates Field in Sun Prairie: The soccer field is located at 1066 Musket Ridge Road.

Directions to field: Take Hwy. 151 to 2nd Sun Prairie exit (Main St). Go right (east) all the way through town. About 3/4 mile after crossing railroad tracks, turn left on Musket Ridge Rd. Follow to park on left, about 1/3 mile.

Sheehan Park in Sun Prairie: The soccer field is located at 800 Linnerud Drive.

Directions to field: From Hwy.151 take the Main Street exit into Sun Prairie. Proceed about 3/4 mile to Walker Way (past Culver's). Turn right on Walker, and follow to Linnerud. Turn left on Linnerud, and follow to field, which will be on right side of street.

Evaluation / Team Formation:

Independent evaluators will assess players' skills so that they can be assigned to teams where they have the greatest likelihood of developing as a soccer player. Teams will be divided by skill level, and every effort will be made to place all players on age-appropriate teams based on individual skill.

In addition to independent evaluation, player's coaches from their previous season will be asked to provide a completed player evaluation form. A combination of independent evaluation, prior coach's evaluation and individual team need will be used in team formation.

Depending on demand, Sun Prairie Soccer Club's first priority is placing players on a team appropriate for their skill level and then their age level. If numbers warrant, some age groups may be combined or reassigned. Keep in mind that just because there is a tryout, does not mean there will be a team; our first priority is placing ALL players on skill appropriate teams.

If a player is unable to attend try-outs he/she must notify the Travel Director at least 24 hours PRIOR to the try-out. Players who are unable to attend try-outs will not be placed on a specific team until they have had an opportunity to demonstrate their skills and abilities, thus allowing the club to place them on the team that would be most appropriate for them developmentally. At the earliest possible opportunity, players should schedule a make-up tryout. If a make-up is not possible, they will be invited to practice with the team that the club believes will be the best fit. Based on their performance at those practice sessions they will be placed on that team or moved to a team more appropriate to their skill level (roster space permitting).

SPSC Fees:

❖ **Try-out Fees**

- A \$30 non-refundable try-out fee (to cover the cost of conducting the try-outs) is required of all players trying out for competitive teams and must be brought to the tryouts.
- An additional \$15 non-refundable service fee will be charged for all player registrations made after May 31, 2010

❖ **SPSC Player Registration Fees**

Registration fees are due within 2 weeks after notification and acceptance of placement on a team. Failure to pay registration fee within two weeks may result in player removal from the team roster. If a player is playing up at a different age level, fee required is based on level of play, not player's actual age.

U11 – U12 Classic \$170 (fall and spring)

U13 – U14 Classic \$190 (fall and spring)

U15 – U16 Classic \$195 (fall – Girls)

U15 – U16 Classic \$195 (spring – coed)

U17-U19 Classic \$215 (fall – Girls)

U17-U19 Classic \$215 (spring - coed)

Annual mandatory registration fees include SPSC membership, Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association registration, insurance, team medical supplies, equipment, field rental fees, uniform, and referee fees. Teams may, at their discretion, charge reasonable fees for tournaments, indoor soccer registration, and other costs agreed upon by the team and its players.

Financial Assistance:

Financial assistance is available for players who would not otherwise be able to play and is based on financial need. Financial assistance is not available to cover the cost of tryouts. Player Commitment:

All players, both Competitive and Travel Rec, are expected to have a solid commitment to their team and coach. This means attending to the best of their ability, all practices, games, and tournaments.
