



Tryout Informational Statement Classic League Competitive Teams 2011/2012 Season

Coaches:

TBD based on teams formed. Coaches are all licensed and qualified for competitive level teams.

Regular Season:

Traditionally 8 league games in the fall and 8 in the spring; at least 2 tournaments, 1 in the fall and 1 in the spring.

League:

Team expected to play in MAYSA's Classic competitive soccer league.

Dependent on team record and further assessment of team ability after completion of fall season the team may move up or down in the spring season if multiple Classic league levels exist.

Commitment:

Players are expected to be in attendance for all scheduled practices. Excused absences acceptable. Unexcused absences may affect game playing time. Absences from practice due to participation in other sporting events will be considered on an individual basis by the coaching staff.

Costs:

Baraboo Soccer Club \$130 (\$65 per fall and spring season; scholarships available); additional tournament fees and/or any other costs agreed upon by the team and its players and parents.

Parents:

- Expected to have their child at the practice field on time and ready to practice.
- Expected to support their player, coach and officials.

Team Formation:

- It is BSC's intention to form classic level teams at the U12-U14 age levels for both mixed and girls' teams. This is dependent on having adequate numbers of players for each age level as well as appropriate skill level to successfully compete in the competitive leagues.
- Every effort will be made to place players on age and skill appropriate teams.
- Please be aware that just because there is a tryout, this does not guarantee there will be a team.

Tryout Sessions:

All tryouts will be held at the soccer field at Boo U and will be held on May 24 & May 25 from 5:45-8:15 with registration prior starting at 5:15.

Placement Offers:

- A limited number of players will receive a written offer to join a specific classic level competitive team.
- The offers will be provided in writing via email.
- It is expected that offers will be made by the club president, a team coach or other club representative on or after June 13.
- Once an offer is made to a player to join the classic level team, they are not required to immediately respond to the offer. All offers are valid for 72 hours from the time of the offer. Players can accept the offer within the 72-hour window. If a player does not accept the offer within the 72-hour timeframe, the offer may no longer be valid.
- Players should accept or reject the offer made by responding in writing to the individual who extended the offer.
- Those players who are not offered a spot on the classic level competitive team(s) will be placed on a recreation level team provided enough players are available to create a viable team. These individuals should expect to receive communication on this decision on or after June 13.
