### Classic (Competitive Travel) Team Player Evaluation Informational Statement for the 2012-2012 Season

#### **What SPSC offers**

Sun Prairie Soccer Club (SPSC) believes every child and adult prospers from the opportunity to play soccer. Playing for a SPSC team means having teammates and coaches dedicated to one another's development as soccer players and members of the soccer community.

SPSC head coaches are licensed by the United States Soccer Federation and the Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association. They are experienced in providing high-quality coaching and leadership to players at a variety of ages and are dedicated to helping players achieve their best. Our coaches are known for their excellent coaching and positive reinforcement. Further, SPSC believes that only through execution of a [Possession Soccer Philosophy](#) can individual players, and ultimately competitive teams, reach their full potential.

#### **Player Commitment**

All players are expected to have a solid commitment to their team and coach. This means attending to the best of their ability, all practices, games, and tournaments. They are expected to demonstrate a commitment to individual and team improvement. Travel is required for away games and tournaments. Over-night stays may be required.

#### **Competitive Teams**

All players interested in playing on a classic (competitive travel) team MUST attend a Player Evaluation. Every effort should be made to be at the Player Evaluation session for the ENTIRE time. Teams will be formed if there are enough players at a threshold skill level to field a team, and SPSC is able to provide appropriate coaching. If a player does not make a competitive team, they will be offered a roster spot on a recreational traveling team, if there is roster space.

**If a player is unable to attend Player Evaluations he must notify the Player Evaluation Director at least 24 hours PRIOR to the Player Evaluation.**

Players who are unable to attend Player Evaluations will not be placed on a specific team until they have had an opportunity to demonstrate their skills and abilities, thus allowing the club to place them on the team that would be most appropriate for them developmentally. At the earliest possible opportunity, players should schedule a make-up Player Evaluation. If a make-up is not possible, they will be invited to practice with the team that the club believes will be the best fit. Based on their performance at those practice sessions they will be placed on that team or moved to a team more appropriate to their skill level (roster space permitting).

#### **Player Evaluation Sign-up**

To sign up for Player Evaluations log on to [www.sunprairiesoccer.com](http://www.sunprairiesoccer.com) and go to the Player Tryouts page. Players can sign up for Player Evaluations at the actual Player Evaluation, but they will be charged a \$20 late fee in addition to the \$30 Player Evaluation Fee.

#### Player Evaluation Fees

- A \$30 non-refundable Player Evaluation fee (to cover the cost of conducting the Player Evaluations) is required of all players trying out for competitive teams and must be brought to the Player Evaluation, if not paid online.
- An additional \$20 non-refundable service fee will be charged for all player registrations made within 24 hours of Player Evaluation or at Player Evaluation.
- Preferably, payment should be made at [www.sunprairiesoccer.com](http://www.sunprairiesoccer.com) using a debit or credit card.

**All players must pay Player Evaluation fee in full PRIOR to the Player Evaluations.  
THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**If a player has not paid the Player Evaluation fee in full, THEY WILL NOT BE EVALUATED FOR CLASSIC TEAM PLACEMENT.**

#### GIRL'S 2011-2012 Season

Players interested in a more competitive soccer experience MAY try out for the next older team. Placement on their current age-appropriate team is NOT guaranteed. If interested in playing up a level, attend the player evaluation for the age-appropriate team as well as the evaluation for the older team. In this example, two fees would be required.

❖ SPSC *may* field the following competitive (classic or state league) girl's teams:

- U11 (born on or after August 1, 2000) – plays both fall and spring seasons
- U12 (born on or after August 1, 1999)— plays both fall and spring seasons
- U13 (born on or after August 1, 1998)— plays both fall and spring seasons
- U14 (born on or after August 1, 1997)— plays both fall and spring seasons
- U15 (born on or after August 1, 1996)— plays fall season only
- U16 (born on or after August 1, 1995) — plays fall season only
- U17 (born on or after August 1, 1994) — plays fall season only
- U18-19 (born on or after August 1, 1993) — plays fall season only

#### CO-ED 2011-2012 Season

Players interested in a more competitive soccer experience MAY try out for the next older team. Placement on their current age appropriate team is NOT guaranteed and requires a Player Evaluation. If interested in playing up a level, attend the player evaluation for the age-appropriate team as well as the evaluation for the older team. In this example, two fees would be required.

❖ SPSC *may* field the following competitive (classic or state league) coed teams:

- U11 (born on or after August 1, 2000) – plays both fall and spring seasons
- U12 (born on or after August 1, 1999)—plays both fall and spring seasons
- U13 (born on or after August 1, 1998)—plays both fall and spring seasons
- U14 (born on or after August 1, 1997)—plays both fall and spring seasons
- U15 (born on or after August 1, 1996)—plays spring season only
- U16 (born on or after August 1, 1995) — plays spring season only
- U17 (born on or after August 1, 1994) — plays spring season only
- U18-19 (born on or after August 1, 1993) — plays spring season only

#### **Evaluation Process/Team Formation**

Independent evaluators will assess players' skills so that they can be assigned to teams where they have the greatest likelihood of developing as a soccer player. Teams will be divided by skill level, and every effort will be made to place all players on age-appropriate teams based on individual skill.

In addition to independent evaluation, players' coaches from their previous season will be asked to provide a completed player evaluation form. A combination of independent evaluation, prior coach's evaluation and individual team need will be used in team formation.

Depending on demand, Sun Prairie Soccer Club's first priority is placing players on a team appropriate for their skill level and then their age level. If numbers warrant, some age groups may be combined or reassigned. Keep in mind that just because there is a Player Evaluation, it does not mean there will be a team; our first priority is placing ALL players on skill appropriate teams.

#### **Registration Information**

After placement on a team, go to the registration page at [www.sunprairiesoccer.com](http://www.sunprairiesoccer.com) to register for the Fall 2011 and Spring 2012 season.

If you are unable to register online, you can download all the required registration information. Or you can request the information to be mailed to you by calling SPSC at (608) 576-PLAY or by emailing the registrar at [registration@sunprairiesoccer.com](mailto:registration@sunprairiesoccer.com).

#### **SPSC Player Registration Fees**

Registration fees are due within 2 weeks after notification and acceptance of placement on a team. Failure to pay the registration fee within two weeks may result in player removal from the team roster. If a player is playing up at a different age level, the fee required is based on the level of play, not the player's actual age.

- U11 – U12 Classic \$220 (fall and spring)
- U13 – U14 Classic \$240 (fall and spring)
- U15 – U16 Classic \$245 (fall – Girls)
- U15 – U16 Classic \$245 (spring – coed)
- U17-U19 Classic \$265 (fall – Girls)
- U17-U19 Classic \$265 (spring - coed)

Annual registration fees include SPSC membership, Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association registration, insurance, team medical supplies, equipment, field rental fees, uniform, and referee fees. Teams may, at their discretion, charge reasonable fees for tournaments, indoor soccer registration, and other costs agreed upon by the team and its players.

#### **Financial Assistance**

Financial Assistance is available for players who would not otherwise be able to play and is based on financial need.
