

Reddan Soccer Park Division Explanation

- All teams are assured at least three games.
 - Between-game break is at least the length of two matches (i.e., approx two hours), except between playoffs rounds.
1. **Eight (8) team Divisions** – split into two brackets of four (4) teams each. All teams in each bracket play each other for a total of three games. Winner of Bracket A plays winner of Bracket B for Championship.
 2. **Five (5) team Division** – each team plays all other teams in the division for a total of four games. Champion and Finalist determined by most and second-most points earned. No semi-finals and no-finals.
 3. **Six (6) team Division** – split into two brackets of three (3) teams each. All teams in a bracket play each other PLUS one crossover game into the other bracket. Winner of Bracket A plays winner of Bracket B for Championship. It is possible that there may be a rematch, in the Championship game, of an earlier crossover game.
 4. **Seven (7) team Division** – each team plays two (2) matches and then teams are seeded one through seven (1-7) based on total points earned in the first two matches. For the third game, the second-seeded team plays the seventh seeded team, three vs six and four vs five. The top seed gets a bye into the semi-finals. Winners of the play-in games go to the semi-finals. Winners of semi-finals meet in the Championship. In this type of Division, a team could lose its first two games and still have a chance at winning the Championship.
 5. **Nine (9) team Division**—three (3), three (3) team brackets. All teams play each other in their bracket. After all team have played first two (2) games, the quarter-final is seeded. All the 2s and 3s match up to determine the top wildcard team. The top team from the wildcard goes in as the lowest seed for the semi-finals, matching up against the top #1 seed.
 6. **Ten (10) team Division** – one four (4) team bracket and two three (3) team brackets. Teams in the four team bracket play three games each with bracket winner determined by most points earned. Teams in the three team brackets play the two other teams in their bracket plus one crossover game. Semi-finals and a Championship match are played in this size Division. Wildcard team is determined based on the team earning the most points which did not win a division.
 7. **Twelve (12) team Division** – three, four (4) team brackets. Teams play the other three teams in their bracket. Bracket winners determined by most points earned. Wildcard is given to team with most points that does not win a bracket. Semi-finals and Championship are played.
 8. **Fourteen (14) team Division** – two, four (4) team brackets and two, three (3) team brackets for a total of four brackets. Teams in four team brackets play all three games within the bracket. Teams in three team brackets play the two teams in their bracket and one crossover game. Semi-finals and a Championship.
