



Reddan Soccer Park Series of Events Participation Agreement

All Reddan Soccer Park events emphasize Fair Play and Sportsmanship. All teams – players, spectators & coaches – are expected to enjoy the event in a positive manner, in cooperation with all tournament staff & officials.

Reddan Soccer Park events maintain and enforce a No Tolerance Policy towards referees. Dissent of any kind from players, spectators or coaches may result in ejection from a match, the sideline(s) or the event.

While winning is what every team strives for, Reddan Soccer Park events put a greater emphasis on player & team development via fair and well-matched competition over winning & losing. It is expected that all participants in Reddan Soccer Park events share this philosophy.

REFUNDS: If the event is called off prior to its commencement, fees shall be returned to the teams less \$100 per team. If the event is called off, refunds will not be given to teams having completed two or more matches. No refunds will be given to teams that drop out after the schedule (even in preliminary/draft form) is communicated.

The tournament committee interpretation of the rules will be final. The tournament committee and sponsors shall not be responsible for any expenses incurred by any team or individual if the tournament is canceled in whole or in part.
