

6.1.3 Club Passing for Recreational Teams

Club Passing is an agreement between teams in the same club to allow players at appropriate age levels to join other teams for league or tournament game play.

- a. A recreational league team may elect to have up to four Club Passing players added to their game day roster. Club Passing is designed as 'intra-club', **not** to be used as an 'inter-club' arrangement between two different clubs. Rec league players may play down to any competitive level within, but not below, their own age group. i.e., a U12 Rec A league player may play on a Rec B or C league team, but not a U11 team.
- b. Club Passing may be used for recreational teams to roster one player over the maximum roster size at a particular age level in order to fill in players up to the maximum roster size in that age group.
- c. No male players will be allowed to participate in female leagues unless designated as a coed league which permits such play.
- d. Teams using Club Passing may need a copy of the official 'WYSA Team Roster' for each team the Club Passing players are coming from.
- e. Recreational players may Club Pass to competitive teams. In this case, a Player Pass, which is required at the competitive game, must be obtained for the Recreational player. (See [Section 2.3.4](#))

6.3.3 Club Passing for Competitive Teams

Club Passing is an agreement between teams in the same club to allow players at appropriate age levels to join other teams for league or tournament game play.

- a. A state league or classic league team may elect to have up to four Club Passing players added to their game day roster. Club Passing is designed as intra-club, **not** to be used as an inter-club arrangement between two different clubs. Classic league players may play down no more than one competition level; i.e., a Classic A league player may play on a Classic B league team but not on a Classic C team. A Classic league player may not play down in age level.
- b. Teams using Club Passing may need a copy of the official 'WYSA Team Roster' for each team the Club Passing players are coming from, as well as their player passes.
- c. Competitive players may not Club Pass to recreational teams for league play; however they may be able to be rostered as a Guest Player for tournament play. Tournament rules vary. Check with the tournament director.
